

## **Powers and Sons Supplier Assessment – Section 16**

The Powers and Sons Supplier Assessment, was developed by the Management Team from questions that conform to ISO 9001-TS 16949, IATF 16949, Customer Specifics and general questions regarding the overall business conditions of the supplier.

An assessment conducted by Powers and Sons shall be considered a 2<sup>nd</sup> party audit.

An assessment will be required on an annual basis, from the supplier, when requested.

Based on the supplier's self-assessment score and or findings, Powers and Sons may elect to perform their own assessment.

Powers and Sons reserves the right to perform their own assessment based upon risk, quality, delivery, or other areas of the Supplier Performance Report that have deficiencies. Corrective Action Plans will be required by Powers and Sons to address deficiencies.

In addition to Supplier Performance Report, Powers and Sons may wish to audit based on awarding new business.
